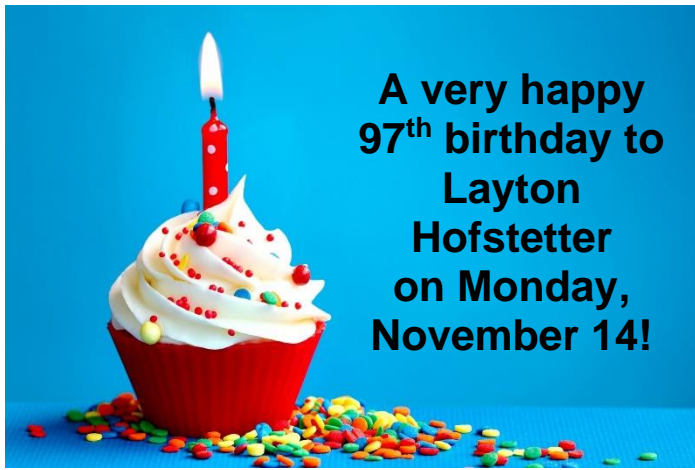

The Board of Peace United will meet on Tuesday, November 15th at 7:15 pm.

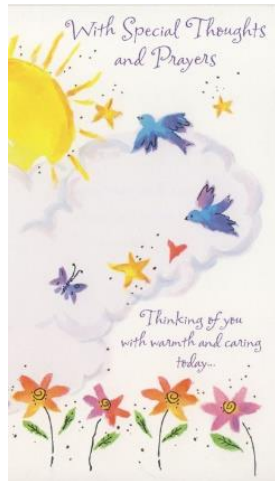

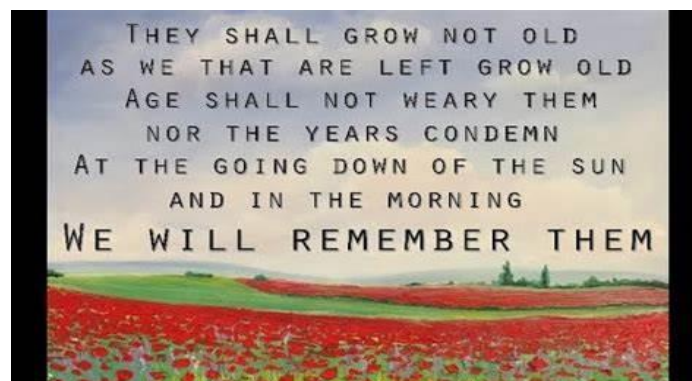
NEW EXHIBIT AT KEN SEILING WATERLOO REGION MUSEUM
