My system isn't perfect, but I feel I've done well applying things I learned from last year to ensure healthy butterflies raised exclusively outside yet protected from their many predators such as wasps, ants, spiders, mantids, stink bugs, other insects, birds, insecticides and lawn mowers. Thank you to Denise for checking in on them when I was away and taking the picture I've included.

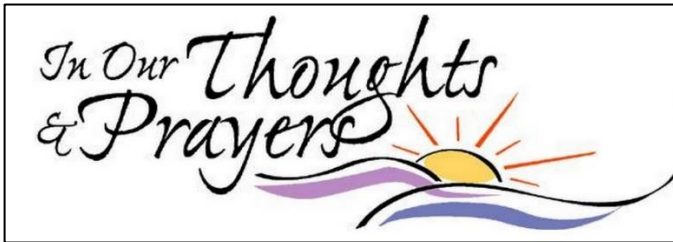


1. MASS CHOIR PARTICIPATION
