May we see this weekend as a celebration of the year and years to come and a fitting way to greet the fall with excitement and hope.

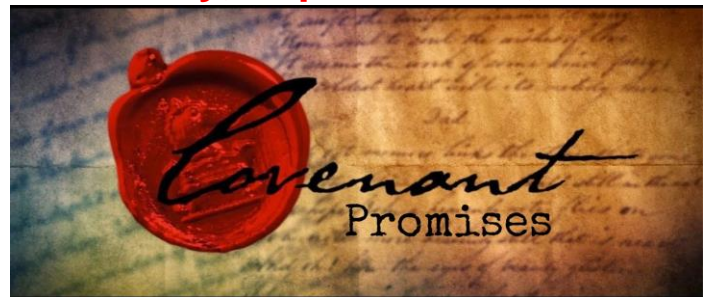
Hope to see you Sunday! I will be in the Peace Office next week on Thursday and Friday mornings from 10 to 1.
